• A Brainstorming-cum-review workshop of District Agromet Unit (DAMU), KVK Cuttack was organized on 26.02.2020 at conference hall of Social Science Division, ICAR-NRRI, Cuttack under the Chairmanship of Dr. D. Maity, Director, ICAR-NRRI, Cuttack.
