KVK Cuttack conducted an ex-trainee sammelan for grassroot level extension functionaries called pranimitras to sensitize them about the current epidemic prevalent in cows, namely, the lumpy skin disease. This exotic viral disease is affecting thousands of cattle across the district causing loss of some lives, but affecting most of the cattle population. To make aware the farming community a technical bulletin was prepared and distributed among the extension functionaries and farmers for effective prevention and control of the disease. They were taught different aspects of the disease and prevention methods besides how to treat the animals after affliction. The management aspects and need for vaccination was emphasized in the training program. Dr Ranjan Kumar Mohanta, SMS (Animal Science) organized the program supported by the KVK Cuttack team.
