

Training for Rural Youth on “Propagation Techniques in Horticultural crops”

Krishi Vigyan Kendra Cuttack successfully organized a 5-day training program for rural youth on “Propagation Techniques in Horticultural crops” at KVK campus, Santhapur from 26.8.22 to 30.8.22. In this training program, 25 no. of rural youth from 3 blocks of Cuttack district took part and learned about different techniques of propagation like cutting, grafting, budding and gooty making. Dr Tusar Ranjan Sahoo, SMS (Horticulture), as training coordinator, imparted both theory and practical classes for their better understanding of skill development in the nursery business. All participants consistently attended practical lessons from 3-5 PM during the session to keep up with their practical learning. They were all given a practical skill evaluation test at the end of the fourth day of training. All rural youths were trained on graft making in Mango, gooty making in Guava, soft wood cutting in flowering plants and budding in rose for means of commercial propagation techniques. During the valedictory session, Sri Soumendra Panigrahi, DDH, Cuttack, encouraged the rural young participants to take advantage of the government's nursery business scheme in the Cuttack district. Dr. Sujata Sethy, OIC, KVK Cuttack, urged the young participants to use KVK technology to enhance their knowledge and abilities in order to create their own enterprises.
