

Capacity Building Training Programme on Scientific Beekeeping

KVK Cuttack organized 3rd batch of 7-days capacity building training programme on “*Scientific Beekeeping*” at KVK Campus, Santhapur from March 11-17, 2022. The training was sponsored by National Bee Board, DAC&FW, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers’ Welfare, Govt of India. A total of 25 farmers/beekeepers in Cuttack district participated in the programme.
