

## New Agro Techniques in Vegetable Production

With an initiative of capacity development of Krishi Mitras working under Mission Shakti, Odisha, KVK Cuttack organized a 5-day capacity building training program for Extension Functionaries on “*New Agro-techniques in vegetable production*” at KVK campus, Santhapur from 5-9 January 2024.
