

## 5 days Training Program on ‘Scientific Dairy Management’

A five-day training programme on ‘*Scientific Dairy Management*’ was organized by Krishi Vigyan Kendra Cuttack from 19<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2026 for thirty farmers and farmwomen under Scheduled Caste Sub-Plan of KVK Cuttack. Dr Ranjan Kumar Mohanta, Senior Scientist and Head and the Course director of the program discussed housing, breeding, feeding, reproduction, and disease management strategies for the trainees. They were also taught about how to select the best dairy animal, how to prepare the concentrate mixture and the ruminant method of feeding the cows. In the training programme, the farmers were trained to treat the animals for common problems like wound management, retention of placenta and metabolic disorders using ethnoveterinary practices. The participants were also briefed about clean milk production, deworming practices and vaccination program for the dairy cattle along with fodder cultivation for quality milk production. The participants were provided with common supplements, and milk can for improving quality milk production.
